4. Policing:

4.1 Sgt Balkeen reported that there have been 36 incidents in the area requiring police attendance.

5. A & B District Councillor:

Several senior managers are leaving A&B Council at the end of the month, and unfortunately this is going to leave a large hole in senior management.

6. Planning and Regeneration:

6.1 The architect will leave in place the existing windows in the tower of the Public Hall.

6.2 KGV Playing Field fence:

ACC is still waiting to hear what is required to rectify the fence following their discussion with the Council Engineer. It is felt that there has been a lack of clarity and support from A & B Council for ACC.

6.3 Airigh Wind Farm:

6.4 Mid-Argyll Watersports:

A decision was made at a recent meeting that, owing to lack of support, the club will have to close down and a report will be made available in due course.

6.5 Traffic Lights:

Local businesses are claiming a shortfall of approximately 50% in their income and they are concerned that this will continue over the summer months. MMS will make enquiries.
